Discuss recommendations with legal guardian if not already done.
Document agreed recommendations and strategies to support oral intake with acknowledged risk.
Speech and Language Therapist/ School Nursing Team/ Medical team to communicate feeding management plan to relevant others via normal distribution methods.
Speech and Language Therapist/School Nursing Team provide relevant training to adults supporting the Pupil to eat or drink with acknowledged risk.
Stage 4: Escalation Planning
Medical team to document suggested management strategies in the event of deterioration, e.g., chest physiotherapy, parenteral fluids, antibiotics; symptom
